Dear Parents,

As part of our Viking topic during the second half of the summer term this year, Class 3 will be visiting the Jorvik Viking Centre in York. This trip offers a unique opportunity to see Viking artefacts first-hand and learn about how archaeologists have discovered so much about the Viking settlements in this city.

The trip will take place on Thursday 17th June, 2010, with the children leaving school promptly at 8:30am and returning to school at 5:30pm. The early start will enable us to reach York by 11:00am, where we will begin at 'Dig!' This exhibition focuses on the job of archaeologists. The children will have an opportunity to 'dig' as archaeologists whilst learning about the Viking artefacts archaeologists have found in York. After lunch, we will visit the Jorvik Centre, which has a fantastic collection of Viking artefacts and many interactive displays that give greater insight into the life of the Viking settlers.

School requests a voluntary contribution of £21.30 towards the cost of the visit. If insufficient voluntary contributions are raised to fund the visit then it will be cancelled. (Please see the school's Charging and Remissions Policy.) The cost is broken down as follows:

Travel, by coach, to and from York: £16.00

Entry to 'Dig!' and the Jorvik Centre: £5.30

On the day, the children will need to wear full school uniform and comfortable shoes and bring a waterproof jacket. They will also need a healthy packed lunch with enough drink to keep them going throughout the day. If the children bring this in a backpack, this will make it easier for them to carry. Packed lunches can be provided for those children who receive free school meals, if you require one please let the office know by Monday 7th June. Children will not need any spending money or cameras.

Could you please complete and return the slip below by Friday 28th May, full payment should be received by this date but can be paid in instalments due to the cost of the trip. Although it is an expensive trip, we hope that it will be both educational and memorable for the children.
