Number and Place Value

I can count to and across 100, forwards and backwards.

I can find more and less than a given number

I can read and write numbers in words

I can identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations.

Multiplication and Division

I can recall multiplication and division facts for 2, 5 and 10 and use them to solve simple problems.

Fractions

I can identify $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, of a number or shape and know that all parts must be equal parts of the whole.
