Dear Parents/Carers,

Book week this year will take place from **Monday 28<sup>th</sup> February to Friday 4<sup>th</sup> March**. As part of our celebrations for World Book Day 2022 **'You are a Reader'** here are some of the events we have arranged for the children:

## **Come to school dressed as a word! - Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March**

As we have had a big focus across the school this year on improving our vocabulary, we thought it would be great for the children to come dressed as a word of their choice. We are hoping that this will reflect the higher-level vocabulary that the children have been learning in their lessons and that it gives them a chance to use their imaginations. We don't expect you to buy any costumes but use what you have at home to create your designs. For example, you may choose the word 'extinct' and come dressed as a dinosaur or 'autumnal' and pin leaves to a jumper. Dishevelled, dress messily or perplexed have lots of question marks pinned to you.

There are lots of different ideas on Pinterest and your child will have a chance to choose a word in class, with the help of their teacher. Prizes will be given to the most imaginative ideas and we are very much looking forward to trying to guess all the different words!

## **Competition- Create a Woodland Creature.**

As part of our ongoing project to improve our Library, we would like the children to design and make some woodland creatures that can live in there. These can be made from any type of material and there will be prizes for the best models. We have included some pictures for inspiration. Please could all finished creatures be in school no later than **Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March** for judging and clearly marked with the child's name and class.





### The Masked Reader

Just for fun, the staff will be creating their own version of the masked reader. They will be disguised reading part of a story and the children will have to guess who is behind the mask!

Teachers will also be sharing their favourite stories with the children across the week.

### Book Hunt

Books will be wrapped up and hidden around school and the school grounds. Each package will contain biscuits and hot chocolate. If a child finds the book they can unwrap it and take it home to share with their family. We ask though that it is returned the next day, so it can be wrapped and hidden again for someone else to enjoy.

### World Book Day Vouchers

Your child will be given a World Book Day token during book week. This voucher entitles them to one free £1 World Book Day book. These can be redeemed in WH Smiths or Waterstones.



### Live Author Events and Workshops

During the week, the children will have different opportunities in their classes to engage in different author events and workshops.
