## Red Nose Day – 18<sup>th</sup> March 2022

Red Nose Day is back and we're all looking forward to a chance to get together for a giggle.

### What is Red Nose Day?

- Red Nose Day is a fundraising event run by Comic Relief
- Comic Relief is a UK charity which aims to create a **just world free from poverty**
- The money raised is used to transform lives in the UK and around the world

To celebrate and support this charity we will be having a dressing up day. Children may come **dressed as a superhero or if they don't have a costume (please do not buy one especially!) they can just wear some red.** We ask for £1 donation that will be given to Comic Relief.

We will also be holding a competition to **design a red nose** and ask for a donation of 20p with each entry. You may print off the attachment or your child can ask their class teacher for a paper copy to decorate. Following the theme of superheroes can your child decorate/design their red nose to represent a superhero or someone they think is a superhero in real life. There will be a prize for the winner in Reception/KS1 and KS2.

However much we raise, it will change lives, both here in the UK and worldwide. In fact, £50 could provide training for a pre-school teacher and a health volunteer to help improve the health, wellbeing and education of young children in Kenya. £500 could get 2,000 meals to children and families most in need in the UK.

We'll also be using Red Nose Day as a learning opportunity to explore issues facing young people across the world, and how the money we raise can help.

We really appreciate your support and hope that you'll have fun helping us raise lots of money for Red Nose Day.
