

The Queen's Platinum Jubilee Art Competition

Her Majesty The Queen is the first British monarch to celebrate a platinum jubilee. That means, she is the first king or queen to have served as the king or queen for 70 years! We would like to celebrate this amazing achievement so the Art Leaders are calling on you to get creative.

What do you have to do to enter?

We would like you to produce a piece of artwork that communicates what The Queen means to you. You can use your own ideas or choose one of these six themes to base your work upon:

- The Queen
- Crown jewels
- 70 years
- Animals associated with the Queen
- Buildings associated with the Queen
- Charities supported by the Queen

Then get creative! You can produce a drawing, painting, sculpture, typography, a piece using textiles or collage (if working on paper, no bigger than A3 sized).

When you have finished your piece, you need to give it a **title** and write a description that will communicate how The Queen inspired you to create your artwork (maximum 50 words). You can write your own ideas or you can use this sentence starter: *What The Queen means to me is...*

When writing your description, you could think about these questions to help you:

Why did you choose to work with those materials?

What inspires you about The Queen?

When do you have to bring your artwork to school?

The deadline for this competition is **Tuesday 3rd May**. Make sure your artwork has your name and class on it and you have completed your competition entry form. Please hand your artwork and competition entry form to your class teacher.

All of the artwork entered will be displayed and judged, and prizes will be awarded to the most inspiring pieces.
