Topic – All Creatures Great and Small

We are excited to be visiting Woburn safari Park on 16th June. As part of this experience, we will be taking part in a classroom interactive talk on skin, scales and feathers.

Geography

We will be looking at geographical features of the Antarctic and how penguins have adapted. We will also be comparing a hot desert to a cold one. We will focus on food chains within this topic and finally compare the Antarctic to the Arctic.
