To complement our study of sound in Science next term, we have invited The Utterly Butterly Ukulele Project (TUBUP) into school on 24th November 2022.

On the day, your child will make their own TUBUkulele, learn how to play a repertoire of songs, and then do an end of day performance with the assembled TUBUke orchestra and the Utterly Butterly Band. The TUBUKes are constructed from an Utterly Butterly tub, a piece of wood and fishing line for strings. To everyone's amusement and amazement, the TUBUke is fully functional and tuneable and is played the same as any conventional ukulele.

This is a wonderful opportunity for the children to develop their understanding of sound and develop their Design and Technology skills. We would love for all children to take part
