Statement of intent

It is our intention to make our club accessible to children and families from all sections of the local community.

Aim

We aim to ensure that all sections of our community have access to the club through open, fair and clearly communicated procedures.

Methods

In order to achieve this aim, we operate the following Admissions Policy.

- 1. We ensure that the existence of the club is widely advertised in places accessible to all sections of the community.
- 2. We ensure that information about our club is accessible in written and spoken form.
- 3. We describe our club and its practices in terms which make it clear that it welcomes fathers and mothers, other relations and other carers, including child-minders.
- 4. We describe our club and its practices in terms of how it treats individuals, regardless of their gender, special educational needs, disabilities, background, religion or ethnicity.
- 5. We describe our club and its practices in terms of how it enables children with disabilities to take part in the life of the club.
- 6. We monitor the gender and ethnic background of children joining the group to ensure that no accidental discrimination is taking place.
- 7. We make our Equality and Diversity Policy widely known.
- 8. We consult with families about the opening times of the club to avoid excluding anyone.

Sessions run from Monday to Friday each week during term time only.
